








Simplified Model of a Sustainable Local Food Economy



Food principles

- Proximity Comes from as close as possible and minimises energy use.
- Provenance The origin of all ingredients are clearly traceable.
- Local control Enables more local financial reinvestment and connection with local communities.
- Justice/Respect Produced, processed and traded in a way that respects and enhances environmental, animal and human health and welfare.
